## Proposed Unit Tribute Plaque

We are allocating funds to support a combined project with the Association and the Drilling Members of the 109<sup>th</sup> Battalion to honor the 109<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment with a “Unit Tribute Plaque” at the National Museum of History of the United States Army, located at Fort. Belvoir, Virginia.

A concept of the Unit Tribute Plaque is shown below as the design is derived from other Regimental Tribute Plaques currently on display at the museum. This is a large-scale plaque that is displayed outside as shown in the pictures below. The Museum handles everything. We just submit the concept along with a \$5,000.00 fee. Once the concept is approved, it is schedule for production and mounting.

Note: Our concept of the plaques is based on the data from U.S. Army Center of Military History 109<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment Lineage and Honors and was approved by our Association Officers, Directors, and Members present at the 4 October 2023 Association meeting.

Our Cost is \$5,000.00.
